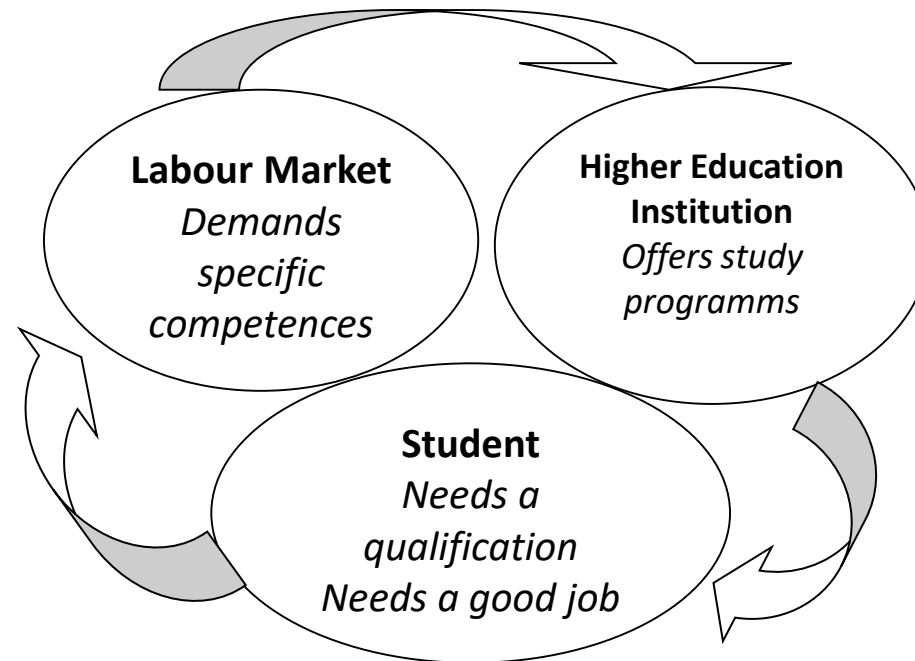


Quality Assurance at Masters Level

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The context



Correspondence to EQF

- ▶ Master studies - level 7
- ▶ 60 - 120 ECTS
- ▶ Bachelor + Master = 300 ECTS
 - ▶ Particularities:
 - ▶ bachelor 180 (3 years) + master 60 (1 year)
 - ▶ bachelor 240 (4 years) + master 120 (2 years)
- ▶ Total / reduced attendance

Accreditation

- ▶ Master program - Master domain
 - ▶ Common objectives
- ▶ Every 5 years - renewal of accreditation
- ▶ 20% of the master programmes

Types of Master Study Programmes

- ▶ Professional master program
 - ▶ training and deepening professional competences
- ▶ Research master program
 - ▶ the training of scientific research competences; constitutes a preparatory basis for doctoral studies
- ▶ Didactic master program
 - ▶ teacher training in various fields

Requirements for external accreditation

- ▶ achievement of the mission and objectives of the field of master studies
- ▶ delivering a process of teaching, learning and assessment centered on student needs and providing appropriate student support services to enable them to achieve the declared results and develop cross-cutting skills
- ▶ ensuring adequate human, material and financial resources
- ▶ compliance with regulations on admission, transfer, student mobility, course and graduation
- ▶ compliance with internal quality assurance procedures
- ▶ compliance with the legislation in force

Criteria

A. Institutional Capacity

1. Institutional, administrative and management structures (ESG 1.1, 1.2, 1.3)
2. Material basis and use of study and research infrastructure (ESG 1.6)
3. Human resources and capacity of the institution to attract external human resources (ESG 1.5)

B. Educational effectiveness

1. Content of study programs (ESG 1.2, 1.3, 1.4)
2. Accessibility of educational resources (ESG 1.6)
3. Learning outcomes (ESG 1.3)
4. Scientific research activity
5. Financial activity of the organization

Criteria

A. Quality management

1. Strategies and procedures for quality assurance (ESG 1.1)
2. Material basis and use of study and research infrastructure (ESG 1.6)
3. Human resources and capacity of the institution to attract external human resources (ESG 1.5)
