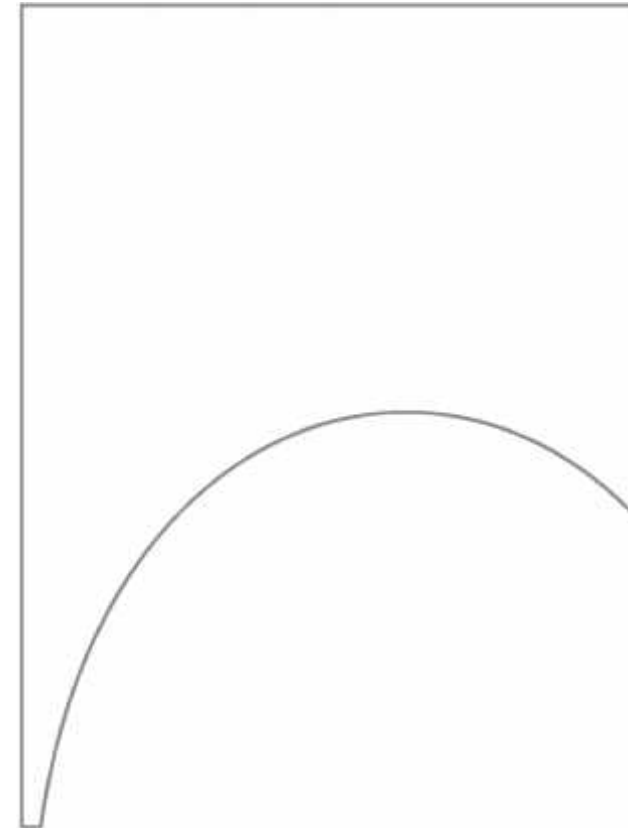

University of Salzburg – Short History

- 1622 – Founded by Prince Archbishop Paris Lodron
- 1810 Closing of the University
- 1962 Re-establishment of the University of Salzburg (Faculty of Catholic Theology and Philosophy)
- 1965 Creation of the Faculty of Law
- 1975 Creation of the Faculty of Humanities and the Faculty of Natural Sciences

University administration

The senior governing bodies of the University are the **University Council**, the **Rectorate** and the **Senate**. The Rectorate is responsible for the management of the University, the Senate for the academic affairs, and the University Council functions as a controlling body.

- **The Rectorate** leads the University and represents it externally. Each member of the Rectorate, in addition to their management and leadership responsibilities, is assigned as priorities specific faculties, Focus Areas, Centers, service facilities and offices of the Rector. A term is 4 years.
- **The Senate** of the University of Salzburg has 26 members: thirteen professors, six representatives of mid-level teaching staff, a representative of the general staff, and six students. The primary tasks of the Senate include approval of the amendments of the University Statute, approval of the design of the Development and Organization Plan; the creation of a short list of three candidates for the election of the Rector of the University; and involvement in the Habilitation and appointment processes. The term of office is 3 years.
- **The University Council**, as the supervisory board of the University, has among its tasks to choose the Rector and approve the draft performance agreement between the University and the Ministry. It also determines the selection of Vice Rectors, on a proposal of the Rector. Furthermore, the Council approves the Development and Organization Plan of the University. The term lasts five years.

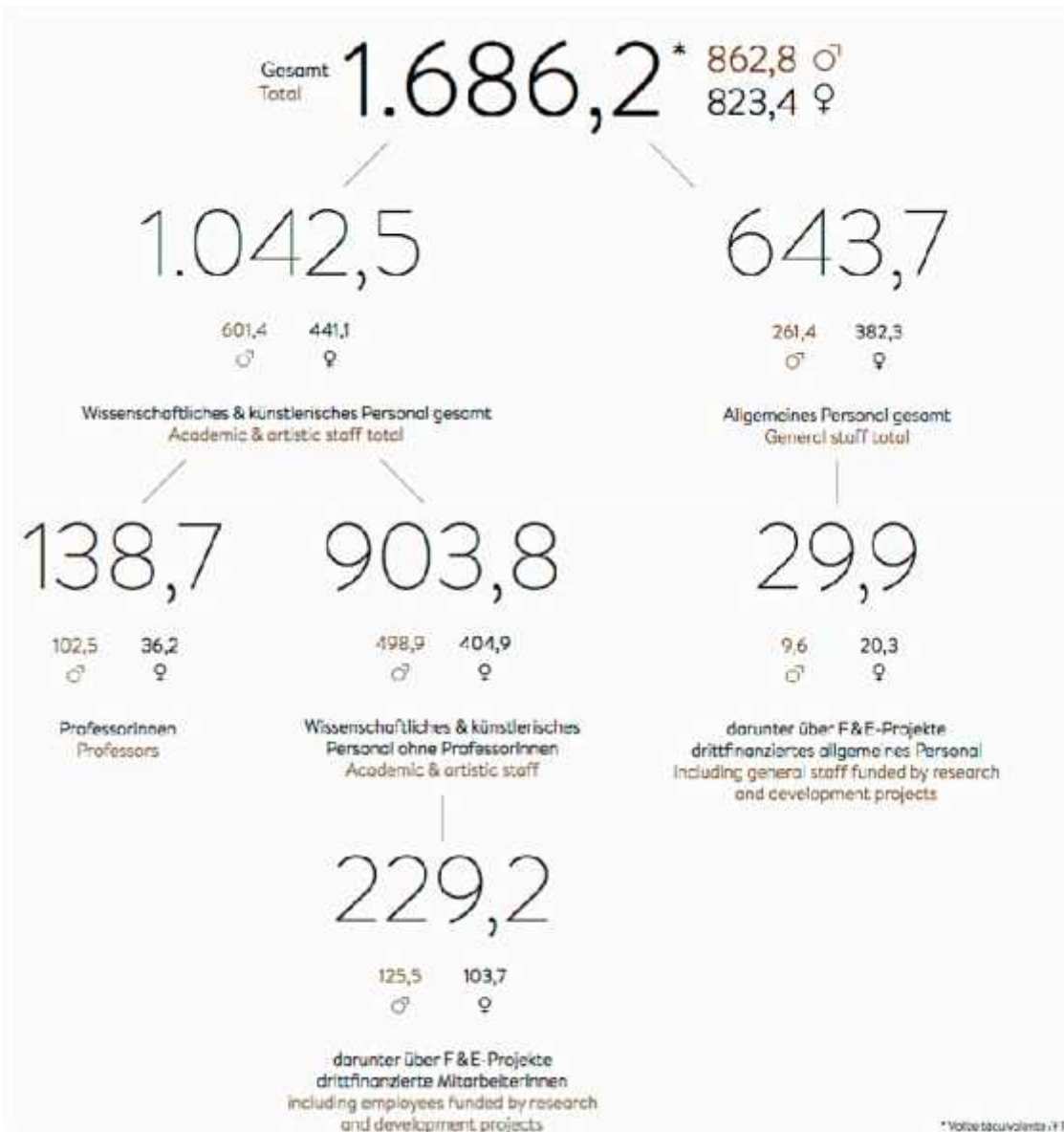
