..Looking Back in History

- officially founded in 1623
- in the beginning mostly theological literature
- oldest book: <u>8th century</u> <u>manuscript</u>
- 375 medieval manuscripts
- incunabula and old prints
- graphics collection



The University Library in 2016

- open to university staff, students, and the general public
- main library and 9 departmental libraries
- In total:~ 2,5 million volumes (main library: 1 million)



Electronic Media

- Online Catalogue "<u>UBsearch</u>"
- Library System: Primo (Ex Libris), used by all of the Austrian academic libraries
- complete holdings (~ 2 million entries)
- Print materials
- Electronic resources:
 - e-books (full text)
 - databases
 - electronic journals (full text)
 - bibliographic records

Accessing (print) materials in the Main Library



- most books , bound journal volumes and newspaper volumes are stored away in the closed underground book stacks
- reference works and basic scientific literature in the reading rooms (first and second floor) can only be used in the library
- Materials from the book stacks have to be ordered via <u>UBsearch</u>
- one hour later books can be picked up at the loan desk (ground floor); books remain ready for pickup for one week



E-Books

- **E-books**: the Library offers a large collection of electronic books, covering a wide range of subjects.
- Titles are registered in the Library catalogue,
 and are linked to the e-book fulltext
- Off-campus access to most licensed electronic media (e-books, databases and e-journals) is possible with a valid university network account via VPN

Borrowing



- Standard Loan period:
 - Main Library: 1 month; renewals possible up to 1 year
 - Departmental Libraries: 2 weeks
- maximum number of books:
 - main library: 15
 - Departmental Libraries: 10
- overdue fines:

standard fine: € 2.00

+ daily fine: € 0.20

- student computers at all of the library locations
- Eduroam (WiFi) access at most of the library locations
- copy machines with print option
- free book scanners for public use
