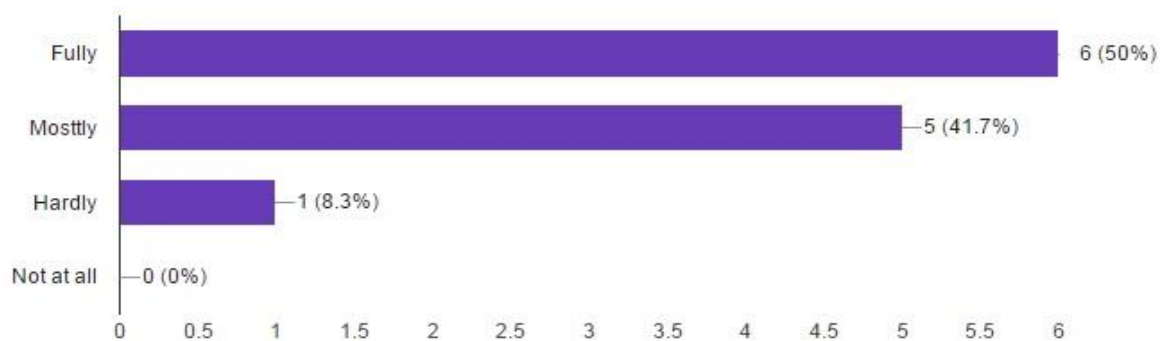

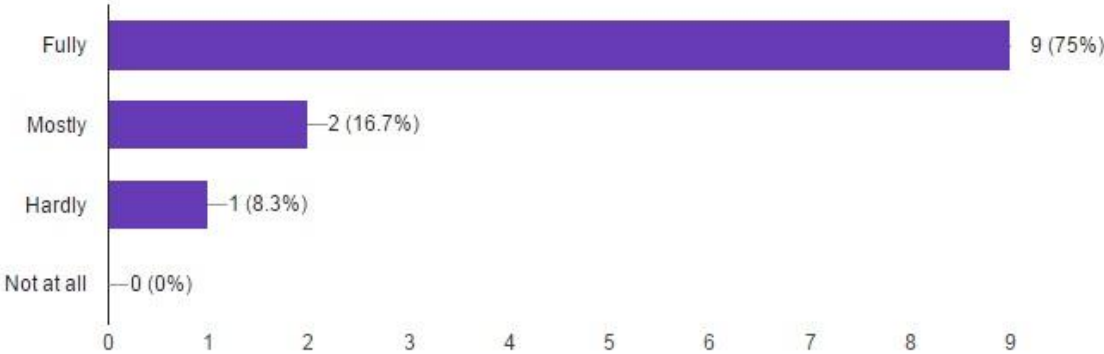

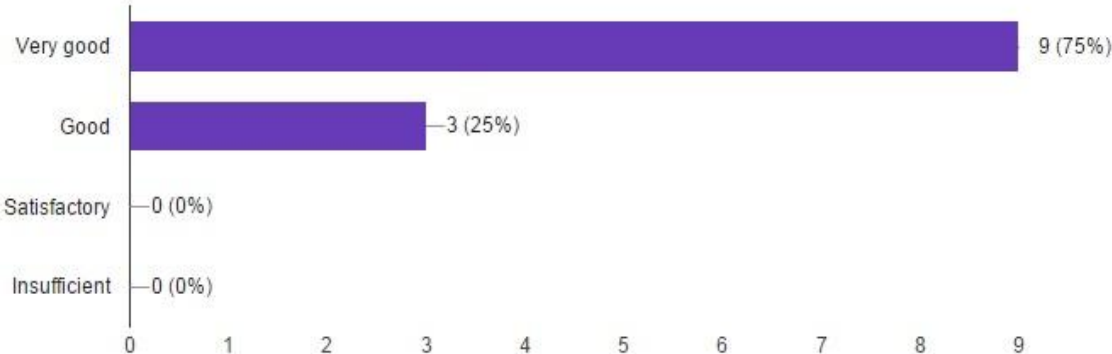

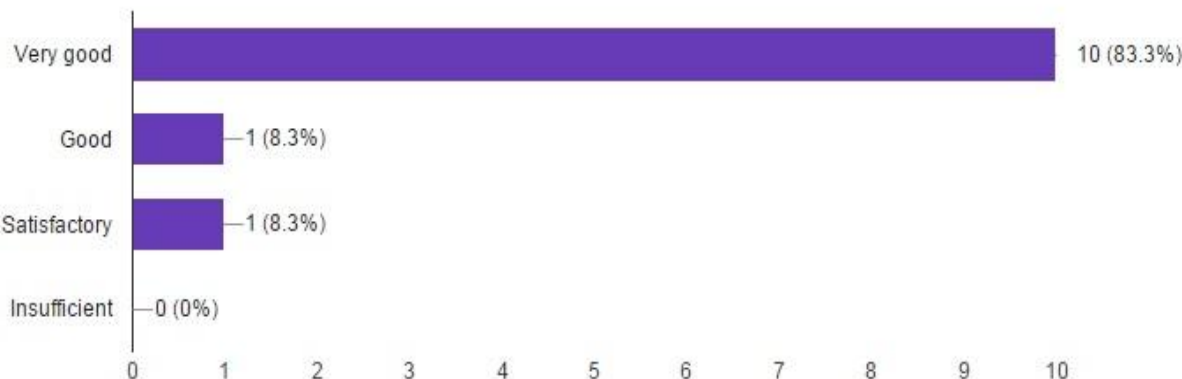

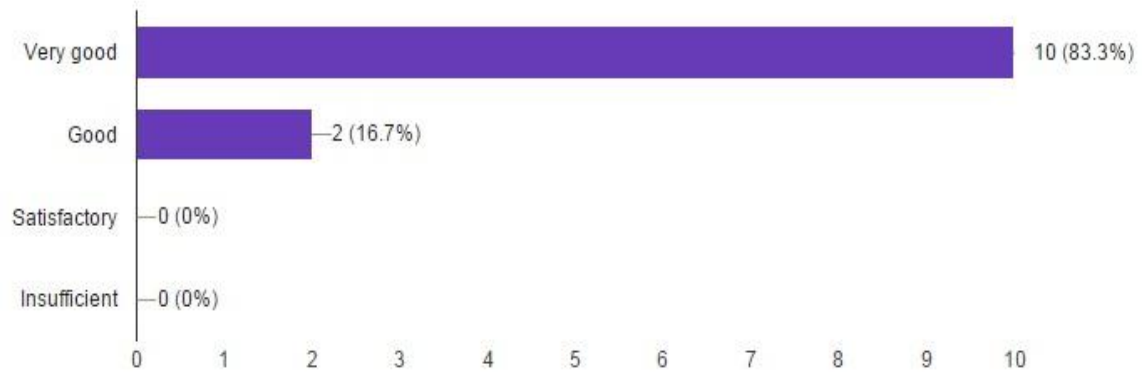
How do you assess the organization of the event/meeting? (12 responses)



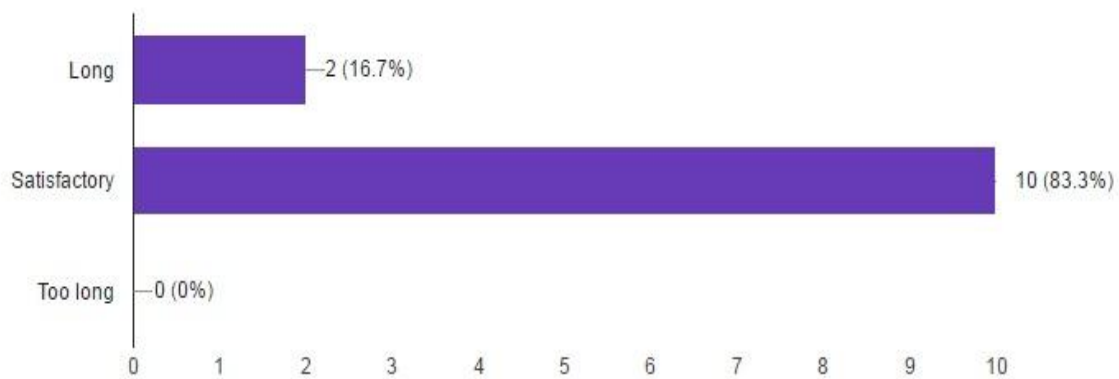

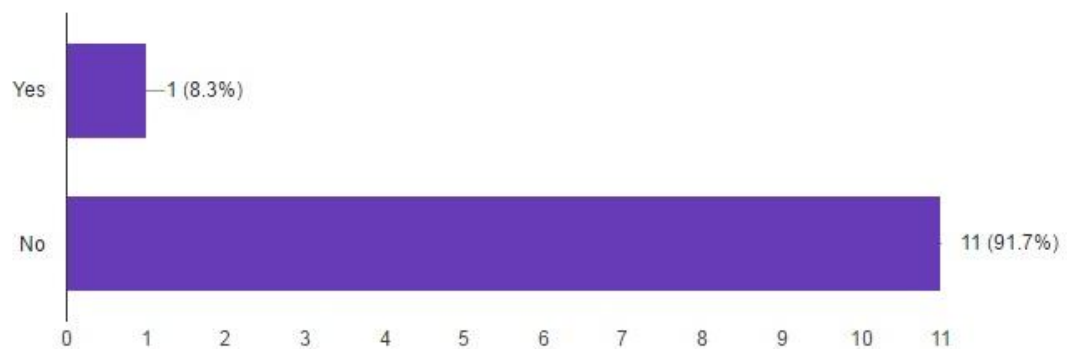
